

SUMMER COURSE QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

**** Please keep in mind that many of your questions can be answered by reviewing the 2023 Air Cadet Summer Training Presentation which is posted under the SSC Documents on the Website****

Q: Can you apply for multiple courses?

A: Yes, will pick your top 3 courses

Q: Is there a cost for Summer Courses for parents?

A: There is no cost for parents – covered by CAF

Q: How will my cadet get to their course?

A: For local CAP courses, parents will need to drop off in the morning and pick up in the evening. For courses that are not local and are overnight course (for example, the three week courses) transportation by air or bus is provided by the program.

Q: Where is the Application form?

A: Will be available to Cadets on their Cadet 365 account and is being sent out by Cpt Halas on February 8th

Q: When is the Deadline to apply?

A: Will be on the form.

- Most courses deadline is Feb 21, 23:59 (11:59pm)
- National courses is Feb 14, 23:59 (11:59pm)

Q: What about Power and Glide Pilot courses?

A: Cadets started online Ground School in September. These names had to be put forward today (February 8th).

Q: Where are Glider and Power Pilot programs?

A: Glider in Brandon, Power is contracted out to Civilian flying schools. These courses are very competitive and we don't get many spots. These cadets have to get to aviation medical. Big thing is that there is a lot of restrictions on medications. Cadets need a category 3 medical. Kids will need that completed by June 1st.

Q: If Level 1's miss a day does that mean that they can't go?

A: Last year this was not an issue, so could be okay this year
